NOTICE

Online applications are invited from Scheduled Tribe (ST) students of Jammu & Kashmir UT including those students who are pursuing studies outside UT in different Government/Private Recognized Educational Institutions undergoing XI, XII, Diploma, Graduation/Post Graduation level Courses, B Ed. M Phil /Ph.D. Professional/Technical Degree Courses at Under Graduate and Post Graduate during the year 2023-24 who intends to avail the Scholarship under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Post-Matric Scholarship to ST students". The ST students have to fill their application forms online on National Scholarship Portal with effect from 22nd of December, 2023 onwards whose income from all Sources does not exceed Rs. 2.50 Lakhs Per Annum. Note: Addition Number is mandafory.

Procedure/instructions for applying to scholarship on National Scholarship Portal (NSP):-REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR FRESH STUDENTS:

- Students applying for scholarship first time need to "Register" on the portal as fresh Portal URL NSP Registration" the icon "New using applicant. https://scholarships.gov.ln/, by providing accurate and correct information as per their documents.
- Before initiating registration process, students are advised to carefully go through the "Guidelines for Registration on National Scholarship Portal" and keep their Educational and other documents such as Aadhaar number, Enrolment number, Bank passbook etc. in hand.
- Fields marked as ** | Real are mandatory. C.
- Upon submitting all the details on registration page, student will get a unique application d. ID and password through SMS on the provided (registered) mobile number.
- The student shall login to NSP using application ID and password received. The student е. must change the password upon first login. This password has to be kept safely and confidentially. The student can change the mobile number only before the first login, i.e. before changing the received password.
- The student can apply in any of the scheme on-boarded on NSP by providing accurate and correct information as per their documents, and shall submit the documents to the Institute after Final submission of the application at NSP portal.
- The detailed procedure for filling the application form has been provided in the User g. Manual for Applicants.

PROCESS FOR RENEWAL STUDENTS

- Renewal Students are the students who have been granted scholarship in any of the scheme on boarded at NSP, in the immediately preceding Academic Year,
- Renewal Students can only apply for renewal of scholarship in the same scheme, for which they have been granted scholarship in the previous Academic Year, Students are bi required to update their marks obtained in previous year and submit the application on NSP Portal. The student must keep the account in which scholarship was received in (i.e. non-dormant) and functional to receive scholarship previous year as active
- In case the student wish to apply for any other scheme, he/she must login using their previous year's application ID and password, select the option for withdrawing the renewal application, and then register as a Fresh Student in the current Academic Year. thereafter, they shall follow the process for Fresh Application.

PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN

- The student/applicant must ensure that the Bank Account details (A/c Number, IFSC Code) submitted is correct and keep the account active (i.e. non-dormant) and functional to receive scholarship amount (i.e. Any condition imposed on accounts by bank, like seeding of AADHAAR, any limit on receiving credit in accounts etc., which may hamper scholarship credit in account should be complied with).
- The student/applicant must ensure that the resolution/quality of documents uploaded is b. adequate so that they are clear and readable.
- The student/applicant must ensure that the mobile number provided in the application is C. correct/Aadhar Linked and belongs to the student/applicant.
- The student/applicant must select the desired scheme from list of schemes available as d. per the eligibility criteria of the scheme(s).
- The student/applicant must take timely action(s) on the SMS received from NSP.
- The student/applicant must follow up with Institutes for application verification before the е. f. deadlines.
- The student/applicant must rectify the error(s) and comply with the remarks made in the g. application in case the application is marked as defective in NSP.
- The student/applicant shall note that applications marked rejected / fake by the nodal h. officer during the verification / reverification process will not be considered for further processing on NSP.
- The student/applicant must carefully select their institute. If applicant selects some other institute by mistake, he or she will have to get their application marked defected from the selected institute and then Institute can be corrected.
- The student/applicant shall note that priority for Scholarship Disbursement will be given to the Aadhaar seeded bank accounts.
- The student/applicant shall note that NSP provides only one chance for updating bank account details (only in case when bank accounts details are not validated by PFMS). Applicants should be cautious to exercise this option, failing which the application will not be considered for scholarship.
- Documents/information required to be uploaded (properly legible) by the applicants. 2.
 - One Passport size Photograph.
 - Domicile Certificate/Permanent Residence Certificate. 11.
 - Valid Category Certificate (Schedule Tribe) Issued by the competent (Revenue) authority. III

- Income Certificate (preferably online). Parents/guardians current family income certificate from all sources in original issued by the Tehsildar concerned. In case of Parent/Guardian is Govt. employee, salary certificate issued by the concerned Drawing & Disbursing Officer. (Income Certificate with cutting/mutation will lead to the rejection of application form)
- Fee receipt in original with name of the candidate, date, Class/semester duly sealed & signed by competent authority.
- Bonafide Certificate. (Only Portal (NSP) generated bonafide certificate duly signed by the concerned Head of the Institution shall be accepted).
- Promotion Certificate/ Marks sheet of last qualified class.
- viii. Valid Hosteller Certificate, issued by the Institution.
- ix. Recognition/Affiliation Certificate of the institution issued by competent authority in case of Private Recognized Educational Institutes.
- Photo copy of the Pass-Book indicating complete particulars i.e., Name of the Account Holder, Address, Active Bank Account Number, Bank Branch & IFSC Code etc.
- xi. Aadhaar number along with photo copy of the Aadhaar Card which has been linked with 16 digit bank account number which shall lead to smooth transaction of sanctioned amount of Scholarship in favour of eligible students.
