ARTICLE 01:

- 2.Registered Office: The registered office of the Association shall be located at Government Degree College Kulgam.
- 3. Jurisdiction: The association shall have jurisdictional access among its alumni.
- **4. Mission:** To inspire lifelong alliance of Alumni with the institution- providing opportunities of interaction for overall growth of the institution of high repute.
- 5. Motto: The motto of the Association shall be "Education for inspiring life".
- 6. Logo: The Association shall have its logo as:

ARTICLE 02: (OBJECTIVES)

- (1) To protect the interests of the Institution, its academic character and to assist in the development of its educational standards.
- (2) To provide a common platform for all the pass-outs to share experiences, knowledge and skills for better future of the current and coming generations.
- (3) To contribute towards the improvement of the current as well as the development of new curriculum and programs at Government Degree College Kulgam (J&K).
- (4) To develop and help maintain active. alumni interactions for enhancing the qualityof academic pursuits of Government Degree College Kulgam (J&K) through self-enrichment, career development and role modeling.
- (6) To aid poor and meritorious students by way of scholarships/ grant in aid/ loan facilities.

ARTICLE 03:

PATRON

The Principal of the college shall be the patron of the Association.

ARTICLE 04:

MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Membership shall consist of three categories
 - (A) Full Members (B) Associate Members (C) Honorary Members
- 2. Eligibility Criteria.

Full membership

- a) Any person who has graduated from the College or has obtained any other degree from this College or.
- b) Any person who has been a student of the college for three years even if not he/she has not completed his/her degree or.
- c) Any Associate member who has been a member of the alumni association of the college for a continuous period of three years.

Associate Membership

- a) Any graduate of a college who is or has been member of the academic/administrative/non-academic staffof the college or.
- b) Any person who is or has been a principal of the college or.
- c) Any person who has been a faculty member of the college.

Honorary Membership

a) Any person who is not eligible to 'Full' or *Associate Membership' but has rendered distinguished services to the college. Inclusion of these members will be decided in Alumni General Meet/Special meeting which ever will be feasible

ARTICLE 05: (OFFICE BEARERS AND EXECUTIVE BODY)

The office bearers of the Association shall be the following:

- 1. a) The President, b) Vice President, c) Secretary General, d) Secretary, e) Joint Secretary, f) Treasurer, and g) two members.
- 2. The responsibility for the management of the affairs of the Association and powers necessary to discharge such responsibility is vested in the Executive body. The powers of the Executive body shall include the powers to pass bylaws in addition to those presently in force. The Executive body of the Association shall consist of the following persons:
- a) The office bearers of the association
- b) Other additional members
- 3. The Office-bearers of the General Body and Executive Body shall be elected at an Annual General meeting and shall hold office for a period of three years. The office bearers and executive members shall be eligible for re-election.
- 4. The executive body shall meet at least twice a year. The quorum of the meeting of an Executive body shall be one third of its total membership.

ARTICLE 06:

COMMITTEES

- 1. There shall be standing committee on:
 - a) College Development b) Student welfare c) Finance d) Continuing Education and Extension Education e) Alumni clubs and Reunions f) Elections and Constitutional Matters.
- 2. The Executive body may, in addition to the above mentioned committees appoint any other committee for specific purpose(s).
- 3. Each of the Standing committee shall be nominated by the Executive Body for a period of one year.
- 4. Each standing committee shall consist of a minimum of three members of whom one should be a member of the executive body.
- 5. All committees mentioned above, except (1) shall be chaired by vice president and for (f) may elect its own chairman.
- 6. Senior member of each standing committee nominated by Secretary General shall function as Secretary of each committee. In addition, Secretary General shall be the

member of the standing committee mentioned in 1() and also Treasurer shall be a member of standing committee mentioned $inl(\phi)$.

ARTICLE 07:

ALUMNI CLUBS, REGIONAL CHAPTERS-ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

- 1. Alumni Clubs, regional chapters alumni association may be formed with the concurrence of executive body, as provided for in the bylaws under this constitution.
- 2. 2 All activities of same may be coordinated by the association and all annual reports should be submitted by its chairman or the secretaries to the association for further consideration.
- 3. 3. 25 % of the membership fee collected by any alumni club/regional chapters alumni association shall be remitted to the account of the association.

ARTICLE 08:

MEETINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION

- 1. The Annual General Meeting shall be held every year before the end of March, at a time and place determined by the Executive Body.
- 2. 2 A special meeting can be convened by the Secretary General at the request not less than fifty percent members of Executive Body.
- 3. 3 The quorum for both the above said meetings shall be 1/10" of the full members, so no decision shall be declared invalid on grounds of any vacancy thereof.

ARTICLE 09:

FINANCIAL MATTERS: SOURCE OF INCOME

1. The Executive Body may authorise any officer or any agent of the Association to enter into any contract and execute and deliver thereof any instrument on behalf of the Association.

- 2. All funds of the Association shall be credited to the Bank Accounts of the association, as the Executive committee may deem necessary from time to time.
- 3. All kinds of payments or indebtedness issued in the name of Association shall be signed by Treasurer and Secretary General, for the same a written receipt shall be issued by the Treasurer. However, donations shall be minuted at the next Executive Body meeting.
- 4. A special fund to be known as the Alumni Association Endowment Fund shall be created and maintained by the Association.
 - a) All pecuniary or monetary gifts made to the Association.
 - b) Such other funds as the Executive Body may from time to time direct, shall be deposited in the Endowment Fund.

Any withdrawals from the Endowment fund shall be at the sole discretion of the Executive Body of the Association.

5. Expenditure from sources other than Endowment fund may be made by the Executive Body.

ARTICLE 10:

FISCAL YEAR AND AUDITING PROCEDURE

- 1. The fiscal year of the Association shall be from the 1" of April to 31 "of March.
- 2. The bi-annual statements must be collected from the concerned bank and audited by the executive body in addition to that Annual Accounts of the Association can be audited by a registered Auditor appointed at the Annual General meeting.
- 3. Any discrepancies in funds, executive council must form committee mandated with 3 to find the reasons if any, for the same.

ARTICLE 11:

SEAL

1. The seal of the Association shall be the Seal engraved with the name of the Association and changes therein shall be decided through meeting.

- The Seal of the Association shall not be affixed to any document except by the Secretary General, in presence of the President or Vice President. 3.
- The custodian of the Seal shall be Secretary General.

ARTICLE 12:

BY-LAWS OF THE ASSOCIATION.

- 1. The President shall exercise the powers normally due to that position. He or she shall have the right to reinterpret any procedural question arising out of clarification. He/she shall preside at all meetings of the association and of the Executive Meetings, in his absence the same meeting will be presided by the vice president.
- 2. The Vice-President shall assume the duties designated to him and shall have particular responsibility of the functions of one of the standing committees of the Association.
- 3. The Secretary General shall be responsible for:
 - a) Issuing of notices for the Annual General meeting, Special General meetings of the Executive Body.
 - b) the preparation, circulation, presentation and maintenance of the minutes and records of all meetings,
 - c) The circulation of the agenda not less than seven days prior to such a meeting and or minutes of meetings.
 - d) The maintenance of the membership registers of the Association.
 - e) The Secretary General shall convene a special meeting of the Association at the written request of not less than one third of members of the executive body.
 - f) The Secretary General shall prepare and present an annual Report of the activities and programmes of the Association at the Annual General meeting,
 - 4. The Treasurer shall assist the Executive body referred to in Article (v) in financial planning and expenditure. He/ she shall be responsible for the maintenance of the proper accounts of the association. He /She shall also prepare and present an annual statement of audited accounts at the annual general meeting.

5. The committee on College Development shall from time to time formulate shortterm and long-term proposals for the development of the college. The committee may suggest ways and means of obtaining financial assistance and getting cooperation to implement such proposals,

- 6. The committee on Student welfare shall promote relations between the alumni and the students of the college. It shall, from time to time, enquire into and report on student welfare services within the college and formulate proposals for their improvement. The committee shall also be responsible for effective links between prospective employers and college students and graduates.
- 7. The committee on Finance shall formulate budget in advance.
- 8. The committee on Public Relations and Alumni welfare shall promote better relations between the college, the Association and the community, through publications, meetings, seminars, workshops, discussions and through mass media. The committee shall formulate proposals for the welfare of the Alumni and conduct activities to enroll new members.
- 9. The committee on Continuing Education & Extension Education shall act as a consultative committee to the college. The committee shall organise and conduct courses, Extension programme workshops, seminars etc.
- 10. The committee on Alumni Clubs and Reunions shall promote and elevate the effectiveness of the alumni clubs, and may make recommendations for their improvement. The committee shall also formulate and submit programme for reunion and other related matters.
- 11. The committee on Elections and Constitutional Matters shall be in charge of recommending proceedings for the conducting of elections and shall advice on the interpretation, modification or amendment of the constitution and of the by-laws. It shall also recommend any constitutional and procedural matters, when so requested and report to the special/general meeting.
- 12. The registration fee a) for members (excluding on roll students) shall be Rs.300/. b) for on roll students shall be Rs. 100/-
- 13. The number of Honorary members shall not exceed filty. The first election of the executive members of the association shall be held at the inaugural meeting of the association and nomination to all he posts shall be accepted at the meeting.

PROCEDURE FOR ELECTING EXECUTIVE MEMBERS

1. The Secretary General shall call for nomination by written notice to all the members, at least one month before the relevant annual general meeting. The electoral list shall the

revised and exhibited in the office of the association. The notice of the meeting shall also indicate that such electorate list is exhibited in the office.

- 2. Nomination for the posts of executive members and other office bearers thereof shall be received by the Secretary General not less than two weeks before the relevant Annual General Meeting. Nominations for the posts if not received in the above stipulated time period can also submit the same during such meeting.
- 3. In case of vacancy/ies during the course of the year, such vacancy/ies shall be filled by the executive committee within one month or at general meeting whichever is earlier

ARTICLE 13:

AMENDMENTS

Any amendment to the above-mentioned guidelines shall require an approval of at least two-third of the full membership present at the Annual General Meeting /Special Meeting but the proposed amendment draft shall be given to each member prior to at least one week.

ARTICLE 14:

DISPUTES

The Executive Body shall appoint a lawyer that shall handle disputes and legal issues, if any, involving the Association.

ARTICLE 15

DISSOLUTION

- 1. The Association shall be dissolved by a resolution passed by not less than two thirds of active and subscribing members.
- 2. If upon dissolution of the Association there shall remain any property whatsoever, after settling all its debts and liabilities, the same shall be given or transferred to Government Degree College Kulgam (J &K).






