Report of the Intra-College Seminar on 'Cleanliness as a Way of Life' on 21st October, 2021

As part of the Clean India Campaign, National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the College organised an intra-College Seminar on the theme, 'Cleanliness as a Way of Life' on 21st October, 2021 in the College Conference Hall. The Seminar saw the participation of 35 NSS Volunteers, besides the members from teaching and non-teaching staff. The seminar started at 11:00 am and the proceedings were conducted by Rakhshanda Irm, NSS Volunteer from the College. In his keynote address, Principal of the College, Prof (Dr.) Nazir Ahmad Simnani introduced the basic objectives of Clean India Campaign and highlighted the importance of maintaining a healthy and hygienic environment.
