
Report of the International Youth Day 2022

National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit and Red Ribbon Club celebrated International Youth Day 2022 on 16th August, 2022 in the College Conference Hall. The event started at 11:40 am and saw the participation of around 70 NSS volunteers besides members from the teaching and non-teaching staff. Principal of the College, Prof. (Dr) Manzoor Ahmad Lone was the chief guest on the occasion and the event was moderated by Dr Safeer Ahmed Bhat, NSS Programme Officer. Dr Safeer Ahmed Bhat introduced the theme of International Youth Day 2022, as "Intergenerational Solidarity: Creating a World for All Ages" before the audience and talked extensively about the way to tackle the global issues and the various recommendations in order to further the agenda of Intergenerational Solidarity and the way it affects the behaviour, the prejudices, the stereotypes and the discrimination that is there between different generations. In his keynote address, Principal highlighted the need to minimize the inter-generational gap to achieve sustainable development goals and reflected that the potential of the youth as well as old sections of the society can be harnessed in order to achieve the harmonious development of the nation. He thoroughly talked about the rationale of the Youth Day and appreciated the contribution of NSS Unit of the College. Besides, he highlighted the importance of counselling, hard work, confidence and endeavour to learn more as the prerequisite for the youth to keep going, the role of youth in 21st century and defined the NSS volunteers as the brand ambassadors of the society.

The event was conducted in two phases. In the first session, Extempore Speech, Reel Making and Painting/poster-making competitions were organised. The main endeavour of the competitions was to bring the youth to a platform, channelize their potential, discuss their problems and bring about the solutions to use the capacity of the youth to the fullest development of the society as well as of the nation. Dr. Hashim Iqbal Malik, Mr. Shahid Yousuf Gilkar and Mr. Iftikar Ahmad Pall, Faculty at the College performed their services as jury. Fifteen (15) students participated in the extempore speech competition. Around 25 topics were written on pieces of paper and speakers were called upon to chose any of the

topics and speak for 2-3 minutes. The students gave a clear message related to the respective topics assigned. A Video Reel making competition was also organised in which 10 volunteers had prepared videos on different aspects of the society and the problems youth are facing. Videos/ reels were prepared on rising drug abuse with special reference to Kashmir, videos on age related problems, psychological depression and trauma and how it can be addressed. Some of the volunteers had prepared posters and paintings on the same theme.

In the second phase, a felicitation ceremony was organised in which the winners of different competitions were felicitated with trophies and certificates. The felicitation ceremony was presided by the Principal of the College. Zeenat Ayash secured first position in the Extempore Speech competition, while 2nd and 3rd positions were secured by Zainab Naushad and Munaza Mansoor, respectively. In the Reel-making competition, first position was secured by Tahir Subzar and Saqlain Mushtaq, 2nd position was secured by Zainab Naushad and 3rd position was secured by Zubair Mushtaq. The event concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Shahid Yousuf Gilkar, Assistant Professor in the Department of English.
