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

Report of one day Workshop on NEP-2020

As part of Teachers day celebrations 2022, National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the College organised a one-day Workshop on 'Changing Role of Teachers in the Context of NEP-2020' in collaboration with the Department of Education on 10th September, 2022. The Workshop was intended to sensitise the NSS Volunteers, Students including Faculty and Scholars from the College about the NEP 2020 and the related aspects. The event was held in the College Conference Hall and witnessed the Participation of around 100 NSS volunteers besides members from the faculty and students from various departments. The proceedings of the Workshop were conducted by Dr. Shahzada Ashraf, Senior Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science who introduced the theme before the audience and talked about the 'Golden Triangle' in NEP 2020: Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment. Honourable Principal of the College, Prof. (Dr) Manzoor Ahmad Lone presented the introductory remarks and formally inaugurated the session, asserting that a new transformation is taking place in the country's academic scenario by way of NEP implementation. He said that the academic institutions require brainstorming frequently to realise the objectives of the Scheme at school, college and university levels. Quoting Dr S. Radhakrishnan, it was held that Knowledge must not be confined to teaching the students only but it must be related to overall development of an individual so that they are able to face the future challenges. The keynote speaker on the occasion, Dr. Mohammad Sayed Bhat, Senior Assistant Professor in the Department of Education at Central University of Kashmir extensively deliberated on the theme. The learned Speaker discussed that the Learning Hubs need to be multidisciplinary institutes, teaching and practising core moral values. While explaining NEP 2020, the resource person focussed on the fact that it was not the policy that would bring change, rather it was the classroom education that does so. He highlighted the vision of NEP 2020, which attempts to provide equitable Knowledge regarding Culture, Inclusion and developing Skills. He reiterated the importance of making the learning Centres enjoyable, engaging & attractive. The address was followed by an interactive session in which various queries were raised by the students and faculty which were answered on the

spot by the resource person. The event concluded with the formal Vote of Thanks by Mr. Mohammad Ashraf Mir, Head, Department of Education.
