Report of the NSS Participation In Annual Urs at Ziyarat Sharif Kulgam

As part of the Community outreach programme, National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the College participated In the Annual Urs of Hazrat Mir Syed Hussain Simnani RA on 16th and 17th November, 2021. Pertinent to mention, Mir Syed Hussain Simnani RA is one of the most revered Sufi saints in Kulgam and his annual Urs sees the participation of hundreds of people from different corners of Kashmir and Pir Panjal region. On 16th November, ten (10) NSS Volunteers, accompanied by Dr. Safeer Ahmad Bhat (NSS Programme Officer) were flagged off by Dr. Nazir Ahmad Simnani, Principal of the College. On reaching Ziyarat Sharif Kulgam, a stall was erected under the banner of NSS Unit, Government Degree College Kulgam. The volunteers established medical and lost/found counters near the main entrance of the shrine. The volunteers rendered assistance to the devotees in various forms, like providing directions to various parts of the shrine, distributing drinking water, helping the management in maintaining Covid-19 SOPs by distributing masks and encouraging the use of sanitisers.
