#### Report of the Events held under My College My Pride

Under the auspices of My Town My Pride and My College My Pride, National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the College organised a series of events on 6th December, 2022. The events included a Campus Cleanliness Drive, Extempore Speech competition and a Seminar on "How is My College Pride for Me?" The main endeavour of organising the events was to celebrate the achievements of the College and instill a sense of pride amongst the different stakeholders.

In the first a Campus Cleanliness Drive was organised in which 25 NSS volunteers participated. Volunteers were divided into different groups to ensure cleanliness of the different areas of the Campus, including Administrative Block, Arts Block, Science and Old Blocks. The collected garbage and trash was collected in Polybags and later emptied into the Bins of Municipal Committee.

In the second phase of the event, an extempore speech competition was organised in the College Conference Hall. Fifteen (15) students participated in the competition. Around 25 topics were written on pieces of paper and speakers were called upon to chose any of the topics and speak for 2-3 minutes. The topics touched different aspects of the College, Administration and Issues faced by the youth. The students gave a clear message related to the respective topics assigned.




