Report of the pre-Camp visit to Ashthal, Kulgam on 6th October, 2021

In view of the Special Camp being organised by the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the College at Ashthal from 8th November, 2021, a pre-camp visit to the adopted village was conducted by the NSS Unit on 6th November. Besides the NSS Programme Officer, members of the NSS Advisory Board, including Dr. Mohd Younes Bhat, Dr. Hashim Iqbal Malik, Mr. Arshid Ahmad Thoker, Ms. Sabah Iqbal and Mr. Wasim Ahmad Mantoo were part of the visiting team. The Board visited different parts of the village to find suitable lodging and boarding space for the Special Camp. It was found that the ground adjacent to the School and Panchayat House was the most suitable as camping site in view of the availability of sufficient toilets and drinking water. The Board also interacted with different persons of the village which included elected Panchayat representatives (Sarpanch and Panches), Numberdar, Chowkidar and members of the village Awqaf Committee. A broad overview of the Camp, its objectives and benefits for the Village was given by the Board members to the visitees. It was decided that the NSS Unit would construct a bridge (of boulders) on the stream running in the middle of the village. It was expected that the project would benefit the villagers to a large extent. The cooperation of the village in the form of bringing forth the problems as well as participation in the orientation programmes was sought for the success of the Camp.
