# Report of the Seminar on Rampant Substance Abuse/ Illicit cultivation of BHUNG/ POPPY

In view of growing menace of drugs and to spread awareness among the students about ill effects of substance abuse, National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the college organised a one-day Awareness cum interactive session/ Seminar on "Rampant Substance Abuse/ Illicit cultivation of BHUNG and POPPY" in collaboration with the Department of Excise and Taxation, South Kashmir Range on 27th December, 2022. The event started at 11:50 am and was conducted partly in Girls Park and partly in the College Conference Hall. The event saw the participation of around 60 NSS volunteers besides members from the faculty and officials from the department of Excise and Taxation. The event was moderated by NSS Programme officer, Dr Safeer Ahmed Bhat, who introduced the theme and brought forth the rationale of the event. Honourable principal of the college Prof Dr Manzoor Ahmad Lone presented the Welcome Address and formally inaugurated the proceedings of the seminar.
