#### **Report of the Celebration of Constitution Day (Samvidhan Divas)**

The event started at 1:00 pm and was moderated by NSS Programme officer, Dr Safeer Ahmed Bhat. In his introductory remarks, he paid rich tribute to Dr. B.R Ambedkar for his peerless contribution in the making of Constitution which has guided the destiny of India as a great democracy. Dr. Mohammad Younis Bhat, Sr. Assistant Professor (Political Science) presented the keynote address.
